The Board of Fire Commissioners of the Sanibel Fire & Rescue District hereby authorizes the Fire Chief: 1) to perform wire transfers to the contractor upon work completion and 2) to approve up to an additional \$500,000 in contingency funds for this project to address changes in the work or the costs as the project progresses.
- Section 3. The Board of Fire Commissioners of the Sanibel Fire & Rescue District requires the Fire Chief to provide updates at each board meeting on the progress of construction and expenditures for the project.
